Remarks		Note : 1. Totally 128 credits are required for graduation: Common Required Course 27 credits + College Core Course 6 credits + Professional Required Course 54 credits + Elective Course 41 credits. 2. Student can take elective courses in this list, and also can take elective courses offered by other departments (with the maximum limit of 12 credits). But cannot take English-related courses offered by other departments. 3. Prerequisite regulations of Professional Required Course: English Grammar (I) and English Grammar (II) are prerequisite for English Writing (I) and English Writing (II). English Writing (I) and English Writing (II) are prerequisite for English Writing (III) and English Writing (IV). 4. The prerequisite rules for the department's required professional courses are as follows: Students who fail both semesters of English Grammar (I) and (II) are not allowed to take English Writing (I) and (II). Students who fail both semesters of English Writing (I) and (II) are not allowed to take English Writing (III) and (IV). 5. Military training and Nursing courses will not be counted towards graduation credits. 6. Form 5 entrants are required to complete an additional 12 elective credits offered by the department, in addition to the original 128 credits for graduation. 7. Students who have not passed the department's foreign language proficiency graduation requirement by the end of the first semester of their senior year must take the elective course Evaluation of English Proficiency in the second semester of the senior year. 8. Regulations regarding graduation requirements shall be implemented in accordance with the department's Guidelines for the Implementation of Graduation Requirements. 9.Students who complete an interdisciplinary or inter-college program may have up to 18 credits from courses offered by other departments or colleges counted toward graduation, provided that prior approval is obtained from the department chair. 10.Beginning with students admitted in the 112 academic year, all students are required to complete 6 credits of inter-college courses before graduation. These credits may include micro-credit courses, self-directed learning, or interdisciplinary learning courses.. 11. Completion of the course "Social Responsibility Practice Education" is required to fulfill the graduation requirement. During the first academic year, students must take at least one university-designated elective course listed in the curriculum, which may be counted toward both elective and graduation credits. Up to two courses may be counted toward the required 6 inter-college credits. Course credit transfer shall be handled in accordance with the university's regulations on credit exemption, with credit adjustments applied when necessary. 12.International students are required to take Mandarin(1) and Mandarin(2). Related regulations are detailed in Implementation Rules for International Students' Enrollment in Chinese Courses. 13.Codes for Off-Campus Internship Courses:(1) Summer Internship (Business Track) ; (2) Full-Semester Internship (Business Track); (3) Full-Year Internship (Business Track); (4) Summer Internship (Teaching Track); (5) Full-Semester Internship (Teaching Track); (6) Full-Year Internship (Teaching Track) ; A maximum of 8 internship credits may be counted toward graduation. 14.As a general rule, lower-year students may not enroll in major required courses designated for higher-year students. Credits earned from such courses taken without prior approval from the department chair will not be recognized. 15.Students who wish to apply for credit exemption for English (1), English (2), Advanced English Reading(1), Advanced English Reading (2), Elementary Japanese (1), and Elementary Japanese (2) should carefully review the Department's regulations and guidelines for exemption of required English and Japanese courses.
